

Authors and illustrators, James and Rebecca Robins, in relating the story to young primary school aged children, have effectively simplified the process of sentencing convicts and sending them to hulks to await transportation.

George, because of his bad character, was to be sent directly to Norfolk Island, but instead was sent to the new settlement which would later become Brisbane Town.

The illustrations by James Robins are historically correct and they suitably enhance a story not readily available to educate young children about Australia's convict past.
